



HOW IT STARTED.

"So, Alex, tell me, when did you arrive in Australia?" It's a commonly asked question in the old language that Alex Glumac gets at Serbian weddings. Donning a smile, he would reply with the unexpected, "I was born and bred here. My parents on the other hand, came to Australia more than 50 years ago."

The guest would be in awe at Glumac's revelation.

"To be honest, I assumed it was a joke when I was first asked this years ago, as Serbs have a penchant to be smart-alecs", says Glumac, who holds a Master's Degree in Communication Management (Public Relations major [UTS]) and an Honours Degree in Communication (Journalism major and History, Politics and Philosophy sub-major [WSU]).

It's one of the many accolades attributed to Glumac, a fluent Serbian speaker, who unlike most Australian-born Serbs, never attended Serbian school. "The Serbian language is difficult, considering it has seven grammatical cases and it's easy to make a mistake. You have to be on top of your game at all times!"

This is why Glumac is in high demand as a wedding emcee in the Serbian community. As a bilingual wedding emcee, he engages all guests, so they don't feel neglected.

"There are older members of the Serbian community who are not well-versed in English, especially when it comes to the entertainment lingo. "By providing on-the-spot translations, I am ensuring they are a part of the celebration and that they feel welcomed. You can see the happiness and sincerity on their faces."

A veteran of the emceeing scene, Glumac hosted his first wedding in 2014. He admits it was a slow start to this journey, as he declined requests at the beginning. Glumac credits his mother, Vicky (Zikica), who encouraged him to further pursue emceeing gigs due to his exceptional writing ability, particularly when it comes to drafting speeches.

"Mum is the reason why I am a wedding emcee in the first place. I recall her once saying to me, 'imagine how far you can go if you applied those skills to yourself?'

"I doubted myself and constantly thought of couples' and guests' impression of me, if I were to make noticeable mistakes, which would ruin the night."

Glumac's self-deprecation began to erode as he focused on nurturing his writing and speaking skills in Serbian, with the help of his parents, Vicky and Fred (Zikica and Radovan). This was further complemented by his then employment as a journalist, speechwriter, and adviser to a member of parliament, whom he would often represent at events as a guest speaker.

Emcees at Serbian weddings are rare. Traditionally, it would be the lead singer of the band, who would assume the quasi-emcee role, by only making announcements with little regard to the flow of the program, which usually results in delays.

Nowadays, venues have strict rules and formalities, which must be adhered to by all vendors. The wedding emcee is integral to the success of the night, by constantly liaising with musicians, photographers, videographers and importantly, the venue manager, to ensure the program is running smoothly, without any hiccups.

As Glumac started developing his emceeing skills, recommendations ensued. He would often be recommended by guests and entertainers, with whom he has collaborated, such as DJ Charger, DJ Drakez, DJ Great Dane, Aleks Koneski, Orkestar Todorovici, and Orkestar Sampioni.

He also assumed the "twofold role" of guest and emcee, having hosted several of his friends' weddings in recent years (a special shout-out to "Brother Nesh" and Suzana Radosevic, Bojana and Toby Salvanos, Chloe and Bojan Karan, along with Tom Gajic, who referred Glumac on to his friends).

Devoid of ego and being down-to-Earth, Glumac was reluctant to create his own Instagram business page, nor to promote himself on social media. "It's quite the paradox when I thought about it. On one hand, you need to promote yourself to get noticed. Yet, on the other hand, it can be seen as an ego-builder, which can be a real turn-off and dissuade others from booking you in."

Glumac credits long-time good friend, Dejan Marinkovic, an accordion player and founder of one of the premier music bands in the Serbian community, Orkestar Sampioni [pronounced Shampioni, meaning Champions in Serbian], for boosting his presence on both Facebook and Instagram.

"Dejan would recommend me to other couples and constantly nag me and say 'dude, you need to have your own MC page.'

"Without fail, he always acknowledges his collaborators in Sampioni's posts. He'd tag my private account, which obviously is not accessible and I have nothing to showcase.

"This went on for several years and I finally decided to open up a separate and public account in March 2020."

Glumac's plan started off well, as requests began to mount. Unfortunately, with the advent of the COVID lockdown introduced by the NSW Government, the wedding industry was decimated overnight. Messages of postponements and cancellations followed. Amid the blatant negativity at first, Glumac soon got into action by fine tuning his Instagram page.

"Photos were not enough, as prospective newlyweds wanted to know what I can bring to the table. I asked previous couples if I could obtain video copies of their reception, so I could only use scenes of myself speaking.

"Thankfully, they were understanding and encouraging, as I respect the privacy of every video. The videos proved to be the ultimate learning tool. I would critique my speaking and emceeing style. I would note my mistakes and work to correct them by constantly practising, especially with more emphasis on ad-libbing."

The hard work has paid off. Glumac is now adept at wedding planning and can tailor a run sheet to a couple's wishes. His emceeing repertoire now sees him hosting weddings from various multicultural backgrounds. He's well-versed in many cultures and it's second nature for him to learn greetings and phrases in other languages, which is a sure way to keep guests entertained.

Boasting a deep, baritone voice, Glumac can easily command the attention of his audience and is a natural when it comes to providing laughter, complimenting speakers during speeches, announcing key formalities and co-ordinating exciting games during the reception.

Glumac finally started gaining recognition in the industry by winning back-to-back Wedding Industry Awards in 2022 and 2023. His endless testimonials have cemented him as one of the most popular wedding emcees in Sydney.

"I am indebted to every couple who has asked me to host their wedding. Each wedding has taught me something new. I've developed new skills and am able to avert problems and handle difficult situations, all while keeping the couple relaxed without any stress."

"To me, the couple are the most important people of the night. I'll do whatever I can to ensure their night runs seamlessly and that they have the best night of their lives!"

HANDY TIPS

Glumac is prone to saying, "there's more to emceeing than just talking on the mic". From the get-go, Glumac requests to meet up with couples ASAP to start the planning process. It's important for Glumac to get to know the couple, by gathering as much information as possible, so he can start preparing their run sheet.

Here are some useful tips for couples to take on board:

Prepare a To-Do List.


This is an absolute MUST for all couples! Ideas will start flowing and it will aid you in your planning along the way. Mental notes just won't cut it, as it's easy to forget the basics!

Songs' Selection.

This aspect of wedding planning can be frustrating and is often left till late in the process. Glumac encourages all up-and-coming newlyweds to immediately start brainstorming a list of potential songs for their entrance, first dance, and the cutting of the cake. It's also recommended that couples speak to their bridal party about their walk-in song choices. The playlist should be sent to the DJ at least two weeks before the wedding date, so the tracks can be prepared.

Music Choice.

Just like the abovementioned point, this is another area of wedding planning which tends to be overlooked. Understandably, the bride and groom want to dance to songs they love (after all, it's their day). It can make the experience all more enjoyable for guests when the DJ cranks up classic hits from the bygone eras of the '80s and '90s (a guaranteed way to ensure the dance floor is always full!). Glumac recommends couples speak to the DJ regarding the songs they would like on the night. This is more so important for multicultural weddings, as the DJ may not have those songs. Preparing a Spotify playlist for the DJ can be a lifesaver.

I believe the best ceremonies are a balance of the serious stuff with a sprinkling of laughter, fun and a whole lot of heartfelt love. Let's get you married!

As the expert, what is your number 1 tip you can share with our audience about wedding planning?

Engage vendors who fit the vibe you are looking to create on your big day, then trust them to support you through the planning process. As an experienced Wedding Celebrant and MC I love to share my tips and tricks to make sure your day is as unique as you are. Don't be afraid to ask for advice and recommendations.

What you the best piece of advice you can give on how couples can make sure their wedding feels true to who they are?

Your day, your way... your big day truly is all about you and the beautiful thing about getting married in 2023/24 is that there is very little you actually 'have to do' to be legally married. Yes there is paperwork to complete and timelines to adhere to, but the legal wording you must say really is quite small (and your Celebrant will be all over this!). This means you can truly tailor your ceremony to suit you as a couple.

Share one of your secret tips with our readers on how they can ensure their wedding goes... Just as Planned.

Your day really will go so quickly, so either hire or assign someone as your on-the-day Coordinator to keep their eye on the time, the run sheet and to be there to juggle all the vendor questions. Then surround yourself with your closest mates - the ones who you feel relaxed around and who make you laugh. Your day will go so quickly so try to have fun and be in the moment as much as possible.

The run down on vows... what you need and where to start!

One of the 'must have' (as in legal bits) that must be included in your ceremony is the exchange of the minimum legal wedding vows. Your Celebrant will write these into your ceremony script and you will repeat after them...super easy.


Many couples also choose to share personal vows. While is completely optional, I must say that personal vows are a super special ceremony moment that you and your partner will not regret including – even if the thought of speaking in front of your guests makes you nervous. Read on for some tips on where to start and other ideas for making your vows memorable.

Where do you start:

Your personal vows are your chance to share your love with each other. Sure, you are getting married and your partner knows you love them, but this is your chance to tell them why. Here are my tips for writing memorable vows your partner will love.

Before you start

Think about your audience (tip - it's your partner, not your guests). While you want to add in personality, and even a bit of humour, you should hold on stories or comments that might embarrass your partner (totally not the time to mention ex's or that time they broke your heart!)



Get out your pen/paper/the back of a napkin/your laptop/tablet or even start in the notes section on your phone... whatever works!! Just start!

Don't over think it – write whatever comes into your head. Aim for 200 words or 3 - 4 paragraphs is fine

What to include and questions to assist

Opening - let them know you are speaking directly to them

o Write like you are writing a letter to this person you are about to marry.

o What do you call your partner? It may just be their name, or you might want to call them by the pet name you call them privately. It's completely appropriate to start with 'Babe' or 'My love'.

Set the scene

- o Remind them of the journey you have been on to get here today.
- o How did you meet?
- o How did you know they were the one?

You are

o What do you love about them?

o Think about the little things that mean the most to you – what do they do to show you their love?

We are

- o Who are you together?
- o How do you feel when you are together?

Your promises

- o What do you promise? Add in 3-5 promises for your life together.
- o These can be a combination of serious and fun.

Sum it up

o What are you looking forward to in the future?

• You may like to sum up with a quote or short poem that sums up your relationship and your hopes for the future.

Next steps:

I recommend my couples send their vows through to me separately so I can check them and make sure they are aligned (ie: around the same length). I also print them out and bring them along to the ceremony.

I am also here to support my couples if they need someone to read them and assist with wordsmithing to make them express exactly what they have in mind.


I also recommend doing a practice run a few days out. Reading them out loud – either to yourself or to a close friend or family member really does assist to calm your nerves.


On the day remember to look at your partner when you deliver your personal vows. You can absolutely read them but take a deep breath and go slower than you think you need to.

As your Celebrant I will be there to support you every step of the way. It's totally fine to get emotional, simply stop for a moment and then continue when you can. If for some reason you can't read on, I can even step in and assist.

Alternatives to personal vows:

If the thought of sharing your vows in front of a crowd makes you break out in a cold sweat, know this is completely normal. Most people rank fear of public speaking as their number one fear, in fact the National Institute of Mental Health reports that 75% of adults say they fear public speaking over death. So ah, just know you are not alone. If reading my tips above has done nothing to alleviate your fears, know there are alternatives including things like: Share your personal vows/promises with your partner privately – either pre or post ceremony You can choose to whisper your vows as part of your ceremony – this makes for a cute moment and the smile on your partners face while you are whispering in their ear makes for great photos Hold your personal vows until your private photo time together and take a moment to say how you really feel out of the eyes of your guests Whatever you decide to do, I will be there to support you. I will probably be looking on with a proud mama kinda smile on my face!







If event planning is something you have no experience with or passion for, enlist either a friend or family member who has the skills and time or hire a professional. It's not a skill we are all born with and that's okay!! What you the best piece of advice you can give on how couples can make sure their wedding feels true to who they are?

Utilize the small but meaningful details to ensure the wedding is a reflection of important things to you as a couple, that way it won't end up as a cookie cutter wedding. This might be something like arranging to have a specific cocktail available that reminds you of when you first started dating, wearing the same perfume you were wearing when you got engaged or swapping out generic groom cufflinks for ones with your pet's face on.

Share the load- you can't and don't have to do it all yourself!!


But there are also a number of reasons you may look for an alternative way to honour a pet on the day.

- The big one (they are no longer alive)
- Your pet isn't into crowds or strangers (even with the support of a chaperone)
- Your venue isn't pet-friendly
- You can't decide which members of your large furfamily can attend and which you'll need to leave out
- You have animals that aren't catered to by pet chaperone services (you kept being ghosted when enquiring about your pet python attending)
- Your cat won't possibly be seen dead on a lead or in a cage
- You are eloping in an exotic country
- The list goes on....

However, if this isn't an option, here are some other ideas for including your pet without them physically being there-

- Cufflinks for the groom with the face of your pet, or mismatched if you have a couple of fur children.
- Have a fun pet portrait created that can sit on the gift table.
- Attach a custom pendant to the bouquet that looks just like your pet.
- Have a mini pet statue as a cake topper, or sitting patiently beside the cake would have to be my personal favourite.
- Incorporate a photo of them into table numbers or place settings.
- Include your pet in the wedding stationary, like custom designed invitations.
- Ask attendees to donate to an animal shelter or rescue organisation in lieu of a gift.
- Mention your pet in the speeches.

I hope that gives you plenty of ideas for how to include your furfamily into a wedding. If you aren't planning a wedding yourself, but know someone who is, be sure to send them this way for ideas too.




We love hearing from incredible and passionate wedding vendors, can you share how you got started in the industry?

Sure! I was initially a nightclub DJ, and got asked to do a friend's wedding. In hindsight I had no idea what I was doing at the time, but I made it work, and I loved every minute of it and haven't looked back since.

Tell us a little more about your business.

Unity Entertainment is a wedding DJ and MC business, delivering a bespoke service, from the initial planning phase, right up to the bride and groom farewell at the end of a wedding reception.

I'm a one man operation - doing all events myself, to ensure it is always a personal experience with quality and consistency. If you book with Unity Entertainment, you will be speaking with me the entire time for the planning and prep work, and I'm the one who will be there on your wedding day.



Can you describe your style and how that can enhance a wedding celebration?

My philosophy is to bring the energy with the music rather than my words. There are some MCs that have a big commanding presence, which is fine, and works well for them. I'm more about ensuring the couple are always the central focus of the day, so I only bring the big voice and energy where necessary and not blather on.

This ethos carries through to my equipment as well. Some wedding DJs like to use big setups with big speaker arrays and festival lighting trusses. My setup is much more minimal - taking up less room and drawing less attention, but still packing the same punch!

On the music side of things, I love to play tracks that span across generations, as you need to in the wedding business. I try to insert my own flavour as much as possible, and avoid the usual 'cliche' wedding songs while still keeping the music familiar and accessible.

What is your favourite wedding trend making its way into 2024?

Abandoning the 'last supper' style bridal table up on an elevated stage. This style seems to be the default for a lot of old school wedding venues, the reason being to make it easier to photograph the couple. It also makes a bit of a divide between yourselves and your guests, and creates the feeling of the bride and groom being unapproachable royalty.

The bride and groom sitting among their guests, rather than overlooking them, is a great way to create a relaxed, welcoming vibe and I'm here for it.

How can couples add more of their own personality to their wedding day?

Reconsider every tradition! You don't need to do a bouquet toss, or even a first dance if you don't want to. Change up the order and format to suit your needs.

Share how your passion for weddings shines through.

On the wedding day itself, I enjoy taking the reins of the proceedings to get the best outcome for couples. After doing hundreds of weddings, I have so much knowledge and advice to share, and love to help out where I can!

What would be one tip you could give to all couples when planning their wedding day?

Find vendors that suit you, and understand you from the beginning, and you won't have to micromanage them. Go with someone that you trust to do the job.

Share your best tip on either wedding planning, the wedding day or after the wedding which is like your own signature.


Keep more of the formalities before the dancing starts - best to not stop the music once it gets going, it's just interrupting a party!

My prices are typically between 1400-1900 AUD depending on time, services needed, and travel.





I like to tell couple to think of the 'barbecue barometer' when writing their guest list. If you wouldn't have the person over to your house for a barbecue, then you might want to think twice about having them witness your wedding.

Book your vendors early! There is nothing worse than having shattered dreams when you find out the vendors you had your heart set on are booked out.

I'm a celebrant - here's why I tell all my couples to write vows, even if they don't want to say them

Picture this. It's your wedding day, and it's exactly what you dreamed of. Actually no, it's been even more magical than expected. Except for one thing. You and your partner are a little shy, so you decided not to have personalised vows read aloud in your ceremony, which is totally fine because it's just not your style. But now you feel a bit like the day has been about the fun, the magic and the party, with a little bit of something missing.

As a marriage celebrant, I'm on a mission to make sure none of the couples I marry have any regrets about their ceremonies. If they don't want to do a ring exchange? No worries! They don't want to walk down the aisle with anyone? Fine by me! They don't want to read personalised vows? Also totally cool! But I WILL encourage couples to write their own vows, and here's why:

Your wedding day is the one day of your lives when, even if you're shy, not soppy, not one to wear your heart on your sleeve, or not one for words, you should be letting your partner know how much you love them, even if they're the only one who hears those words.

And here's the good bit: you certainly do not have to read personal vows out aloud in your ceremony (just the legal vows, which your celebrant will help you with). I encourage couples to think outside the box so that their vows can be shared in whichever way suits them best. This might mean they write them in a card that is delivered to their partner the morning of the wedding as they're getting ready. Maybe they share them together over a drink at some point between the ceremony and reception with no one else around. Or maybe they're texted the next day, sent at the same time and read over a coffee.

One of the most romantic ways to keep vows intimate is to do 'whisper vows' - where you whisper them into each other's ears during the ceremony while the celebrant moves the microphones away so not another soul can hear, but guests can feel the electricity of your love as they watch you. Trust me, this is a guaranteed goosebump starter!

Before my couples say "but Bec, I can't write!" I make sure they've got my nifty Vow Writing Guide in their hands. I always say, your love is there in your heart, that's why you're getting married, some of us just need a little coaxing.

There is a simple formula to nailing your vows, and with a little help and a little love, you'll make sure you have no regrets on your wedding day too.

So ask your celebrant for some help, and know that you can slay your day your way!







In lieu of a bridal shower, I opted to spoil my two bridesmaids at a day spa. What a great destress in the lead up to the big day. We had a ball.



How did you choose your wedding vendors?



When I edit my galleries, I am always calling my partner into my office to see how cute the photos turned out - I'm just obsessed with photos that showcase love.

Add on a polaroid album! This is an add on service that I offer, where I take a few rolls of polaroid film throughout the day, and arrange it into an album that I gift to my couple before I leave the wedding. It's an adorable way to reminisce on the night right away.

I'm based in Sydney, Australia, but I've shot weddings in different states in Australia and I am always happy to travel anywhere to shoot a wedding!

What is your price guide?



With a hint of gullibility, I bought a \$90 push-up stick of foundation, believing in the adage that higher prices equalled superior quality. I proudly displayed it on my bathroom shelf, a statement of my brand loyalty.

The euphoria, however, was short-lived. Four weeks in, I was plagued with headaches and nausea whenever I wore it. A noxious odor lingered, and I thought the product might be spoiled due to my careless display where the sun may have got to it. Ignoring my reservations, I decided to take it back and purchase another one. The saleswoman asked why I was buying another seeing as this one was far from finished, so I filled her in on the noxious smell, my headaches and nauseousness and I suggested it may be off. She scoffed and told me that they all smell like that and that I was overreacting. I hadn't, so I did.

With my two young boys by my side, I declared "I can't be the only one allergic to your toxic rubbish. I'll make my own makeup and I'll do it in two weeks!" (Looking back, I have no clue why I settled on that timeframe). The words were out, a challenge to myself, and a stand against subpar products. Despite my lack of experience, I now had a bee in my bonnet and was determined to change the narrative.

Two and a half weeks turned into two years of relentless trial and error. Once again, I began with research, and by research, (I was much wiser now) I mean avidly standing in shopping centres surveying women and asking them what they would like from their "ideal" makeup products. This revealed much and proved incredibly valuable. These results became my criteria list to formulate to.

I had absolutely no makeup background and hadn't worn any until my late twenties. But fuelled by a passion to provide women with makeup that exceeded expectations, I plunged into formulating my own range. The process was chaotic – mixing and re-mixing, checking against my criteria list, and discarding anything that fell short. Each time this happened (and it happened a lot in the beginning) I gathered more insights into products and into the industry. An industry that I could see desperately needed to change!

My stainless steel bench migrated from the kitchen to centre stage as I balanced marriage, motherhood and entrepreneurship. My boys became accustomed to the sight of their ghostly mother amidst powder and scales, their curiosity and support unwavering. Despite the odds, I presented, transformed and talked about my passion for safe, high-performance makeup for days. An unexpected turn of events led to the prestigious international BEST Brand Award, a moment that affirmed my journey from a kitchen novice to an international player.

Yet, success was not without setbacks! A disastrous attempt at national distribution left me financially drained. My management skills were weak and had faltered and I had to burn and learn. Another financial hit came with packaging. I purchased 40,000 jars from China that came with sifters that were too loose and wouldn't stay in the jars. This was only noticed once they were all full and on the shelf. A costly error that only reinforced the importance of quality control. It was like my determination and grit were being tested, but these were all valuable lessons I needed to learn.

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Through the highs and lows, one thing remained constant, my commitment to providing makeup that truly performed. My formulations defied industry norms, diffusing fine lines, instead of emphasizing them, products that last all day, long shelf life, protection against the suns burning and ageing rays, products that stand up to humidity and perspiration, cruelty free and vegan and so much more. These were not just makeup products; they were tools for empowerment.

The journey from regret to empowerment was not linear. It was filled with audacious decisions, hard-won lessons, and moments of triumph and despair. But within that journey lies a brand – NAS Cosmetics. The success of my formulations comes from embracing my lack of industry knowledge, daring to use high-end ingredients and listening to what the women told me they truly want from their ideal products.

From my humble beginnings to becoming a true powerhouse in the makeup industry is defined by an unwavering commitment to quality, safety and the use of natural ingredients. 


What you the best piece of advice you can give on how couples can make sure their wedding feels true to who they are?
